## EMPTY CONTAINER CERTIFICATION FORM

I hereby certify that these containers are "empty" as defined by regulations of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) regulations, 40 CFR 261.7. All material has been removed that can be removed using common practices appropriate to the particular contents and type of container (e.g. "drip dry"). \*In addition, under the rules of the U.S. Department of Transportation (D.O.T.), all openings on the empty containers are closed and all required marks and labels are in place as if the containers were carrying their full original contents.\*\*

\*E.P.A.'s regulations (40 CFR 261.7) states a container is empty if:

All materials have been removed that can be removed using practices commonly employed to remove materials from that type of container, (e.g., pouring, pumping and aspirating) AND (for viscous materials):

No more than 2.5 centimeters (one inch) of residue remain on the bottom of the container or inner liner.

For containers equal to or greater than 110 gallons, no more than 3% by weight of the total capacity of the container remains.

For example: 275 gallon I.B.C. 275 (gallons) X 0.3% = .825 gallon

For residues of "P-List" products specifically listed by name in 40 CFR 261.33 (e), E.P.A. says the packaging is empty ONLY

"if the packaging...has been triple rinsed using a solvent capable of removing the product, or be cleaned by another method show to achieve equivalent removal."

\*\*D.O.T.'s 49 CFR 173.29 states that all openings on the empty packaging must be closed, and that all markings and labels must be in place as if the drums were full of its original contents.

\*\* D.O.T. regulations on emptied hazardous material containers are published in 49CFR 173.29 \*\*

PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY DRUMS THAT ARE REJECTED DUE TO THE FACT THEY DO NOT MEET R.C.R.A. STANDARDS WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU! YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKE THE SHIPPING ARRANGEMENTS AND BILL OF LADINGS ON THESE CONTAINERS SINCE SOME MAY HAVE TO BE HANDLED AS HAZ-MAT SHIPPING.
